FRENCH MUSLIM CELEBRITIES TO BE FASTING

USPA NEWS - In France, it is official, the holy month for Muslims, Ramadan begins today Tuesday, April 13, will begin the holy month of Ramadan for all Muslims around the world. The announcement of the start of Ramadan 2021 was unveiled by the organizations gathered at the Great Mosque of Paris on Sunday evening during the "Night of Doubt" (FFAIACA, GMP, MF and RMF) and recorded the same date as that determined by the French Council for Muslim Worship (CFCM). The Minister for Citizenship urged Muslims in France to practice the month of Ramadan, while responding to the press about anti-Islam graffiti. In fact, anti-Muslim tags were found on April 11, 2021 on the walls of a Muslim cultural center in Rennes (Brittany): "The Crusades will resume "[?], "Charles Martel saves us"[?]. Two days before the start of Ramadan, racist tags discovered Sunday morning on the walls of a Muslim cultural center in Rennes sparked a series of condemnations, some denouncing an "anti-Muslim climate". The Minister of the Interior Gerald Darmanin, went there in support of the Muslim community and judging these acts "to express" all the disgust that we inspire these inscriptions which are insults, insults to French Muslims

THE CFCM ANNOUNCES THE BEGINNING OF THE MONTH OF RAMADAN 2021 HOLLY MONTH OF MUSLIMS-

The French Council of Muslim Cult (CFCM), which is the referent body for the representation of Muslim worship in France, had determined the date of April 13, in an official statement, earlier this month. The CFCM considers that astronomical calculations make it possible to determine in advance when the Moon is visible in the sky. Based on science, the CFCM also said that the end date of Ramadan was known: Aid El fitr is this year set for Thursday, May 13, 2021, according to this body.
