Israel launched the current war by attacking worshipers at Al-Aqsa Mosque

Israel suspended international flights

USPA NEWS - Israel launched the current Palestinian war by attacking worshipers at Al-Aqsa Mosque on Al-Quds Day last week. The Western media is only covering this war in the name of Gaza and we are labeling it as terrorism by the Palestinians while Gaza and Palestine are one and the same.

The media is also reporting that Iran has fired rockets directly at Israel. Iran has provided rockets and missiles to the Al-Quds Brigade. Western media is spreading false news that only the military part of Hamas is fighting Kataib Izz al-Din al-Qassam. Other Palestinian resistance groups, including Saraya al-Quds, a leading Palestinian Islamic Jihad militant group.

Other Palestinian groups in Gaza are also involved in the war. The Western media repeatedly mentions only Hamas in order to divide Palestinian groups. So far only rockets have been fired from Gaza. There are no rockets in West Jordan and there is full Israeli control. Hamas expelled Israel from Gaza in 2005 after a fierce battle. Israel's Iron Dome automatic rocket and missile defense system is not comprehensive enough to stop all rocket attacks.

Despite this, it has been able to prevent 50 to 70 rocket attacks because the Palestinian resistance has fired a large number of rockets. In just 48 hours, more than 1,000 rockets have been fired, of which about 250 to 400 have hit the target. It is being spread on social media that the Palestinian attack did not cause any significant damage to Israel. An oil refinery, Ashkelon power plant, 12 large buildings, several houses, a pipeline, the port of Ashkelon, two buses, a military barracks and other targets have been destroyed, reports Israel said.

The oil refinery destroyed in the attack was recently awarded a 800 million contract with the United Arab Emirates. Israel is giving the impression that it does not care about these attacks.

Currently, 50% of Israeli citizens spend the night in underground shelters. All government offices in Tel Aviv have been relocated and 5,000 reserve troops have been called in. The Palestinian resistance did not have that many rockets in 2014, 2009, 2007 and before. They only threw stones at the soldiers. Israel used to make excuses for invading the Palestinians from time to time and destroy their remaining power. Hezbollah dropped 4,000 missiles on Israel in the 33-day war of 2006, which prevented the Zionists from returning, or they would attack every two years. Israeli media are reporting that Palestinian rockets are not modern that cannot hit their target and are destroyed in mid-air.

The current attack has failed the Iron Dome, an air-to-air missile destruction system, and has used some advanced guided missiles that have caused trouble for Israel, which is hiding its devastation from the world and its people. Armed clashes continue in several places in Israeli-occupied Palestine. Palestinian armed groups have seized three police stations in Haifa and set them on fire. Police have fled the city of Al-Lad and occupied the area. The situation in the Beersheba area was not under the control of the Zionists.

Palestinians are also fighting in Al-Quds and Al-Aqsa. Almost all Zionists have been evacuated from East Jerusalem. The Israeli population is moving to larger cities to seek refuge from the suburbs. Israel has also suspended international flights.
